Established in 1951, IOM is the leading inter-governmental organization in the field of migration and works closely with governmental, inter-governmental and non-governmental partners. With 175 member states, a further 8 states holding observer status and offices in over 100 countries, IOM, the UN Migration Agency, is dedicated to promoting humane and orderly migration for the benefit of all. It does so by providing services and advice to governments and migrants. Brazil is a Member State of IOM since 2004.

Context

IOM in Brazil with funding from the United States Agency for International Development (USAID) is currently implementing the project "Economic Integration of Vulnerable Nationals from Venezuela in Brazil". The project aims to contribute to the economic integration of vulnerable nationals from Venezuela and other neighbouring countries in Brazil by ensuring access to sustainable livelihoods and employment opportunities. This will be achieved through cooperation with the private sector, government bodies and civil society partners. Through capacity-building activities of private sector employers and local stakeholders, the project aims to ensure that they have the capacity to hire, support, integrate and absorb migrants in their companies and communities. The project will secure the development of capacities of stakeholders on socio-economic integration and protection of migrants ensuring the longer-term sustainable impact.

The project supports the Government of Brazil's broader "interiorization" program which relocates willing Venezuelans from the remote border region of Roraima to larger population centres. In particular, the action will be implemented in the following states: Federal District, Mato Grosso, Goiás, Paraná, Rio de Janeiro, Rio Grande do Sul, Santa Catarina, Pernambuco, Ceará, Bahia, Rio Grande do Norte, Paraíba, Minas Gerais, and São Paulo.

Under the overall supervision of IOM Brazil Chief of Mission and the direct supervision of the Project Manager in Brasilia and the Project Coordinator in Minas Gerais, the Consultant will be



based in the city of Patos de Minas and will be responsible for supporting socio-economic integration activities in the state.

Objective: Support implementation of IOM "Economic Integration of Vulnerable Nationals from Venezuela in Brazil" project, carrying out activities to promote protection and local integration of migrants from Venezuela and other neighboring countries.

Responsibilities and Accountabilities

- 1. Support the reception and integration of Venezuelan refugees and migrants supported by the Job Placement Modality in Government Relocation Strategy ("Estratégia de Interiorização"), in coordination with IOM's Project Coordinator.
- 2. Support mapping private sector actors who are willing to engage with the economic integration of migrants.
- 3. Plan and organize training/workshop on ethical recruitment of migrants mixing the themes of ESG and Agenda 2030/SDGs.
- 4. Participate in meetings, events, and other related activities.
- 5. Support in outreach activities with private sector partners to enhance employment opportunities for migrants.
- 6. Aide the developing and dissemination of informational materials from IOM.
- 7. Support the monitoring process of the integration of Venezuelans in the assigned territory, maintaining direct contact with migrants.
- 8. Undertake site visits and duty travel as required.
- 9. Develop and present a methodology, workplan and timeline for the development of the above-mentioned activities.
- 10. Support collection of data and reports elaborations and systematizations.
- 11. Assist the Project Coordinator with the preparation of reports, ensuring proper information exchange on all operational aspects of the project.
- 12. Promote awareness-raising activities and/or visits to local private sector stakeholders.
- 13. Read and analyse Key IOM Guidelines, Key International Guidelines, Standards, Frameworks and Policies, including other UN System references specially ILO documents, PSEA, and other reference material provided by IOM team.
- 14. Deliver monthly reports containing the performed activities as well as supporting documentation.
- 15. Perform other work-related tasks, as required.
